Energy Efficient: 7/8" insulated glass helps combat rising heating and cooling costs. Optional LoE² Glass provides superior energy savings, keeping your home warmer in the winter and cooler in the summer. Dual weatherstripping creates a virtually weather-tight seal, helping to eliminate drafts.

Dual ball bearing, self-leveling rollers and a rigid rolling track result in smooth, effortless operation. 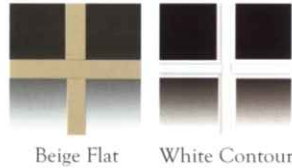

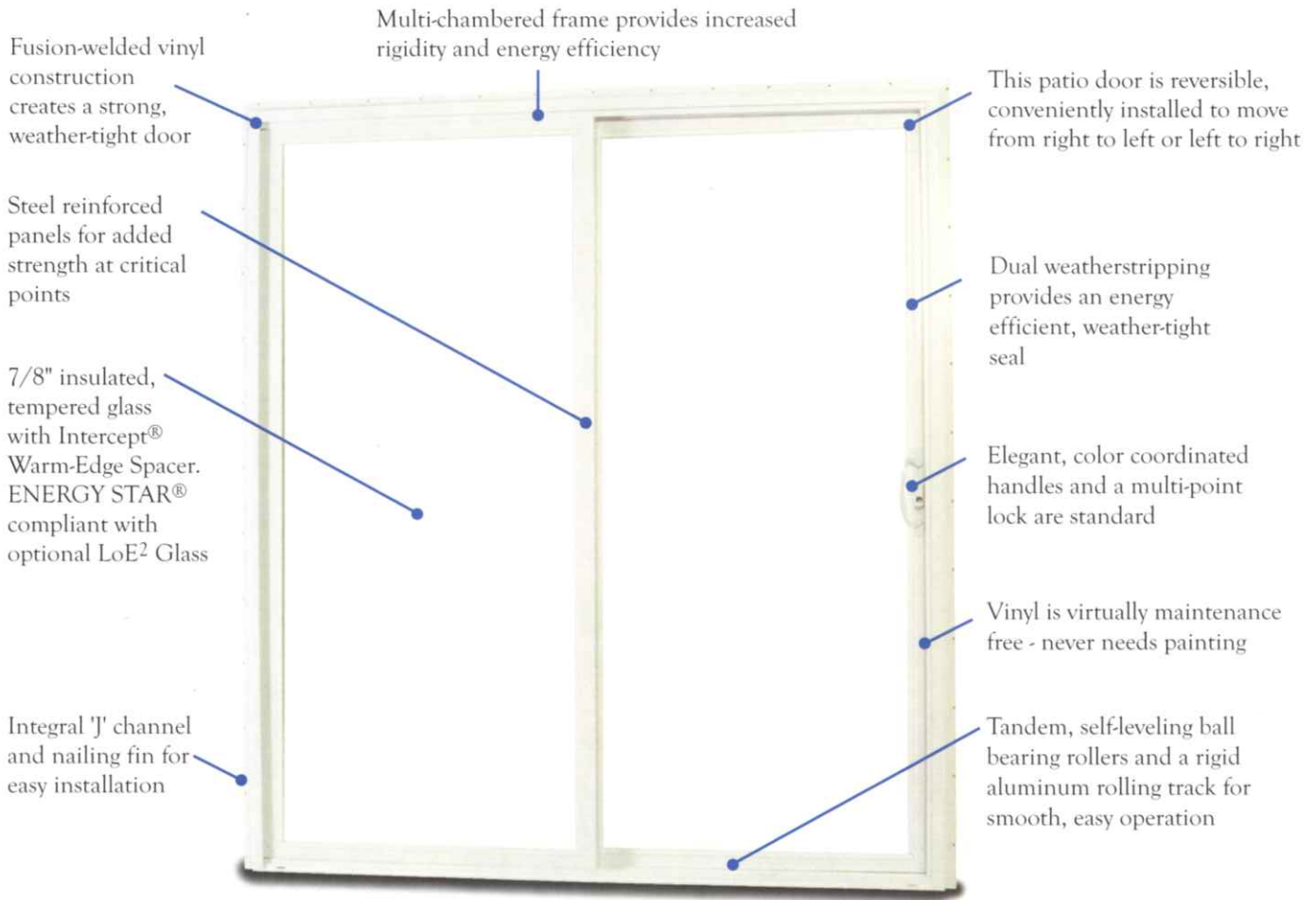
